



Cheyenne Junior League Baseball Scholarship Program

Introduction: Cheyenne Junior League firmly believes that each child who wishes to play baseball should be entitled to do so regardless of skill, gender, or financial circumstances. Our league will not deny any child a chance to play baseball due to a financial hardship.

Scholarship Program: To aid parents who may need assistance with registration fees, Cheyenne Junior League has a comprehensive scholarship program that covers the following areas:

- Full scholarships that cover all the registration fees.
- Partial scholarships that cover a portion of the registration fees.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements: Those seeking a scholarship must explain the nature of the hardship and provide the required documentation supporting the request. Specifically, to be eligible for a scholarship (full or partial), the following information must be submitted in person to a Cheyenne Junior League Board Member:

- Scholarship Application completed in full.
- Detailed explanation of a financial hardship.
- Supporting documentation required:
 - Copy of a current Free/Reduced Meals Approval Letter from the school district, or
 - Copy of a current Food Stamps Approval Letter from the Wyoming Department of Family Services, or
 - Copy of a current Power Approval Letter from Wyoming Workforce Services, or
 - Copy of a current Social Security Determination Letter from the Social Security Administration, or
 - Copy of current year Tax Return (if completed) or most recent year Tax Return, and
 - Current Registration Form with Medical Release, and
 - Proof of age for new players (Birth Certificate).

What Every Parent Should Know: Before submitting the scholarship application to Cheyenne Junior League, parents should be aware of the following:

- The scholarship request process is very straightforward. To ensure proper due diligence, every scholarship request is reviewed and assessed on its own merit.
- The scholarship application will not be considered if all the requirements are not met in the application process.
- Cheyenne Junior League Board reserves the right to ask for the required supporting documentation, to include proof of income and any additional information to make our decision.
- The scholarship review process turnaround time is within 15 days.
- If the scholarship application is approved (full or partial) the Cheyenne Junior League Board reserves the right to ask that the parent volunteer time to offset the registration fees. Depending on a full or partial scholarship, the volunteer time could be up to 10 hours throughout the season (1 hour of volunteer time = \$10.00 that we scholarship).
- When the scholarship application has been reviewed, the parent will be notified by email or phone the outcome and the volunteer time required if approved.

Terms and Conditions: If the scholarship request is approved, the following Terms and Conditions will apply:

1. The scholarship covers the registration fees only for the current season in full or in part.
2. Parent agrees to “re-pay” the League through Volunteering for League functions and activities (for example; field clean up, field maintenance, working concessions, fundraising activities, etc.). Each hour volunteered will be the equivalent to \$10.00 credit towards the scholarship until the entire amount has been paid.
3. An additional option to “re-pay” the League is through Fundraising (for example; selling Fundraiser Discount Cards, selling New Sponsorships, etc.).
4. All of the registration information must be current and accurate (Parent contact names and phone numbers).
5. The Cheyenne Junior League Board President will maintain the Volunteer Records, so it is the parent’s responsibility to check in and out with the President when asked to volunteer time.
6. Parents and Players must adhere to the Cheyenne Junior League Code of Conduct.

Full and Partial Scholarship Application

Cheyenne Junior League will not deny any child a chance to play baseball due to financial hardship. Full or partial scholarships are available. Complete and return this application, required documents, registration form with medical release and a proof of age to a Cheyenne Junior League Board Member. A separate scholarship application must be completed for each player.
